What is MOPS?

MOPS stands for Mothers of Preschoolers, although all mothers of children age 0-5 are welcome. **The purpose of MOPS** is to encourage, equip, and develop every mother of preschoolers to realize her potential as a woman, a mother, and leader in the name of Jesus Christ.

MOPPETS Caregivers are needed to provide childcare during the MOPS meetings.

When moms know that their little ones are being loved on and cared for, they're able to relax and fully participate in MOPS ... which allows them to grow in their relationships with their church, family and God. Our MOPPETS program provides care for children ages 6 months through kindergarten. While mothers attend the MOPS meeting, the children enjoy a program designed to meet their needs.
